

## DIGITAL File Rules for Celtic Challenge 2008

This information applies to all Digital Files submitted to this year's Celtic Challenge  
The Digital Files will be projected on a Canon XEED SX50 Projector with PC/Laptop running Windows XP  
which has been calibrated. Images will be projected using Adobe Bridge software.

**All Digital files are to be submitted in the following format –**

- a) **Mode – RGB Colour, 8 bits only or Greyscale, 8 bits**  
**Please Note - The projector works in the colour space – sRGB**, your images will be converted to this by the projector automatically, but it is recommended that you submit your files in sRGB (additional notes available)
- b) **File Format – jpeg or tiff (no compression)**
- c) **Image Size – 1400 pixels horizontal, maximum  
1050 pixels vertical, maximum**  
Please Note – 1400 x 1050 is the native resolution of the projector so these dimensions will give optimum viewing (if you supply as 1024 x 768 they will appear slightly smaller on the screen). DPI makes no difference but you may set 96 dpi if you wish.
- d) **Images must not contain layers - they must be 'flattened'.**
- e) **The picture area itself (image area 1400 x 1050) must not display the title or author name.**
- f) **Image 'Filename' – Your images should be numbered 01, 02 and 03 etc. (as they appear on the entry form) followed by \_ and the two characters for your country\* (from the list below) 'in capital letters', followed by \_ and then the title (maximum of 20 characters with no spaces);**  
(please note that the character \_ used in the filename is an underscore not a hyphen)

**\* We will identify the countries by the two character codes listed here -**

**Filename Example –**

- the file name for the 2nd image, 'Misty Loch Ard' for Scotland would be ..... 02 **ML**\_mistylochard.tif **or** 02 **ML**\_MistyLochArd.jpg

or - the filename for the 10th image, 'A Day at the Races' for North Wales would be ..... 10 **LL**\_aDayAtTheRaces.tif **or** 10 **LL**\_adayattheraces.jpg  
You may capitalise the title as you wish but please leave no spaces.

- g) **Please submit all of your images together on one CD, they MUST NOT be submitted by email.**
- h) **You must write your files onto a 'CD-R' and make sure that the 'session is closed'.** Please make sure that your CD can be read and opened on a computer other than the one it was written on. **Write your name, phone number & e-mail on the CD in case we have any problem opening it.** Please do not stick labels onto your CD not meant for that purpose.
- h) **Please make sure that no 'virus' is present within your CD;** all CD's will be checked when submitted, any found with a virus will not be submitted.
